On 7<sup>th</sup> February, exam boards published 'advance information' to let you know some of the aspects of the specification that will be assessed in examination papers in Summer 2022.

Advance information will detail the focus of particular aspects of the examination; for example, the content, contexts, texts, topics, sub-topics, themes and skills that will be assessed in the 2022 exams.

**The advance information will not always detail everything that is in the examination. You will still be taught the full specification.**

This arrangement applies to all GCSE and A Level subjects except GCSE English Lit, GCSE Geography, GCSE History and GCSE Art & Design. The support that you receive in these subjects will be different to the arrangement for all other subjects and your teacher will tell you more about this.



# Advance Information



Advance information does not require any changes to a question paper's usual structure, which means that the examination assessments will:

- be familiar to students
- allow continued relevance of past papers
- support your confidence with the layout and structure of question papers

Your teachers will use advance information to support you to focus your revision and examination preparation. It cannot be taken into the examinations. Advance information will not be detailed enough to enable you to guess or predict specific questions or answers.
