UNIFORM INFORMATION

At Norton College our ethos is built around six core values which create ASPIRE - achievement, self-belief, pride, independence, respect and engagement. As a college, we take great pride in our uniform and the students' appearance. Students are expected to look neat, tidy and business like at all times. Uniform should be clean and repaired or replaced if necessary; we welcome your support in ensuring that students adhere to this expectation. As we near the end of the academic year, we would like to take the opportunity to remind you of the Norton College uniform policy in readiness for September.

Girls' Uniform

- Maroon blazer with school logo
- White shirt with long or short sleeves
- School tie
- Grey school skirt from the school supplier OR Grey trousers from the school supplier
- Only dark grey/black or white socks are allowed
- Dark grey or black tights
- Plain black leather shoes (slip on or lace up).
- No high heels, training shoes, boots or plimsolls allowed.
- School jumper from the school supplier

Optional

Plain, outdoor coat or jacket. Hoodies are not to be seen on site.

Boys' Uniform

- Maroon blazer with school logo
- White shirt with long or short sleeves
- School tie
- Grey trousers from the school supplier
- Only dark grey/black or white socks are allowed.
- Plain black leather shoes (slip on or lace up).
- No training shoes, boots or plimsolls allowed.
- School jumper from the school supplier

Optional

A plain, outdoor coat or jacket. No hoodies or other jumpers. Hoodies are not to be seen on site.

Hairstyles

Fashions evolve over time and we remain aware of changes in trends. However, extreme hairstyles and colours are not permitted. The School is the arbiter of what is considered 'extreme'. If in doubt, please contact the school.

Jewellery/Makeup

- Students are allowed to wear only one small plain gold or silver stud in each lobe.
- A wristwatch (*not* Apple Watch or similar) may be worn.
- Bracelets – one small thin bracelet
- Necklace – one small thin chain worn underneath the school shirt.
- Make up – discreet

Unacceptable jewellery will be confiscated.

Visible tattoos are not acceptable. This includes eyebrow tattoos/lines or shapes cut into eyebrows.

Students are not allowed to wear any visible body piercings, other than those mentioned above. This includes nose studs, tongue studs or any facial piercings. Students are not allowed to cover piercings with a plaster.
