

Dear Parents of Year 11 Students,

As outlined in the letter sent at the end of the summer term, we are intending to issue results to Year 13 students in person this **Thursday 20th August**. However, in line with government advice, the arrangements will be different to previous years. **Students will collect their results at an allocated time from Hudson Hall**. The specific detail of when and where your son/daughter should collect his/her results was included within the letter.

In line with the government's advice, please note the following important information:

- Students should come onto the school site to collect their results alone and should not travel with other students. Parents should not come onto the school site nor congregate at the school gates. If you do need to drive your son/daughter to school, please park on one of the surrounding roads and wait for him/her to return to you.
- On entering the school building through main reception students should sanitise their hands straight away.
- Students will be expected to leave the school site once they have collected their results. Students should not congregate on the site.
- In line with the government's advice, please note that there will only be a small number of staff in school on the day, so the majority of follow-up issues will need to be addressed by appointment. Senior staff will be in school in order to offer advice and guidance as necessary 09:00-13:00 on Friday 21st August and Monday 24<sup>th</sup> August. As you will be aware, the government has announced that there will be a full series of GCSE examinations in all subjects available in autumn 2020. GCSE examinations start on Monday 2nd November and finish on Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> November.
