

The wearing of full school uniform is expected as an integral part of the school ethos which promotes positive attitudes, high standards and a sense of personal pride.

Students are expected to look neat, tidy and business-like at all times. Uniform should be clean and repaired or replaced if necessary; we welcome parental support in ensuring that students adhere to this expectation. We have a small amount of spare uniform in an emergency for students to use.

Girls' Uniform

- Maroon blazer with school logo
- White shirt with long or short sleeves
- School tie
- Grey school skirt from the school supplier OR Grey trousers from the school supplier
- Only dark grey/black or white socks are allowed
- Dark grey or black tights
- Plain black shoes (slip on or lace up). No high heels, training shoes, boots or plimsolls allowed.
- School jumper from the school supplier

Boys' Uniform

- Maroon blazer with school logo
- White shirt with long or short sleeves
- School tie
- Grey trousers from the school supplier
- Only dark grey/black or white socks are allowed.
- Plain black shoes (slip on or lace up). No training shoes, boots or plimsolls allowed.
- School jumper from the school supplier

*In line with government guidance, students should wear a face covering at all times inside the school buildings unless they have a medical exemption. Those exempt will wear a lanyard indicating this. This will be reviewed throughout the year in line with government guidance.

Optional

Plain, outdoor coat or jacket. This may be worn in class due to increased ventilation needed to reduce the risk of COVID 19 infection. It must **not** be worn as an alternative to a blazer however. It must be worn in addition to a blazer

Hairstyles

Fashions evolve over time and we remain aware of changes in trends however, extreme hairstyles and colours are not permitted. The School is the arbiter of what is considered 'extreme'. If in doubt, please contact the School.

Jewellery / Makeup

Students are only permitted to wear:

- One small plain stud in each lobe
- Wristwatch
- Thin bracelet/necklace worn underneath the school shirt

Not permitted:

- Rings
- Nose studs, tongue studs or any facial piercings

Unacceptable jewellery **will be confiscated**, and the behaviour system implemented.

- Makeup should be discreet, which includes false eyelashes, and nails should be short and unvarnished.
- Visible tattoos are not acceptable. This includes eyebrow tattoos / lines or shapes cut into eyebrows.

Where uniform is incorrect, students will be asked to remove or replace the incorrect item with something more appropriate. If student does not comply, the behaviour system will be implemented.
